AN ORDINANCE REVOKING TWO EXISTING 15' SERVITUDES ACROSS CERTAIN 4.07 ACRE TRACT OF LAND, LOCATED IN SECTION 13, T6S-R3E, LIVINGSTON PARISH, LOUISIANA, IN FAVOR OF THE LAND OWNER, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED ON THE ATTACHED PLAT.

The following ordinance which was previously introduced in written form required for adoption at a regular meeting of the Livingston Parish Council on August 14, 2014, a summary thereof having been published in the Official Journal together with a notice of public hearing which was held in accordance with said public notice, was brought up for final passage on September 11, 2014 on Motion of Joan Landry and seconded by Sonya Collins:

LIVINGSTON PARISH ORDINANCE NO. 14-32

AN ORDINANCE REVOKING TWO EXISTING 15' SERVITUDES ACROSS CERTAIN 4.07 ACRE TRACT OF LAND, LOCATED IN SECTION 13, T6S-R3E, LIVINGSTON PARISH, LOUISIANA, IN FAVOR OF THE LAND OWNER, BEING MORE PARTICULARLY DESCRIBED ON THE ATTACHED PLAT.

WHEREAS, by the official plat of MAP SHOWING THE REVOCATION OF TWO EXISTING 15' SERVITUDES ACROSS A CERTAIN 4.07 ACRE TRACT OF LAND, LOCATED IN SECTION 13, T6S-R3E, G.L.D., LIVINGSTON PARISH, LOUISIANA FOR JOHN BLOUNT, by Alvin Fairburn & Associates, LLC, dated June 23, 2014 recorded as Plat Book Entry \_\_\_\_\_ in the office of the Clerk and Recorder for the Parish of Livingston, State of Louisiana, attached hereto and made a part hereof by reference, is located two 15' servitude across certain 4.07 acre tract of land.

WHEREAS, a petition has been addressed to the Livingston Parish President-Council by John Blount, as the current owner of the two existing 15' servitudes across a certain 4.07 acre tract of land, requesting the revocation of said servitudes.

WHEREAS, the Livingston Parish President-Council is of the opinion that the two existing 15' servitudes across a certain 4.07 acre tract of land, as described above, is not needed for public purposes.

BE IT ORDERED by the Livingston Parish President-Council, acting in accordance with R.S. 48:701, the two existing 15' servitudes across a certain 4.07 acre tract of land, is hereby revoked and set aside.

The effective date of this ordinance shall be as prescribed by law.
